

# Playground Rules

1. Follow the Tribes Agreements.
2. No one likes to be bullied. Show good sportsmanship, take turns and follow the rules of the games you are playing.
3. Students must ask permission to leave playground or go to the bathroom.
4. Students must stay where duty teacher can see them.
5. If a ball goes into the road, one student must get permission from the duty teacher to retrieve it. If the ball continues to go out in the road, it will be taken away.
6. No toys on the playground other than hoola hoops, jump ropes or balls that belong to the school.
7. Rough housing and play wrestling are not allowed. Keep your hands and legs to yourself.
8. Inappropriate language, taunting, or bullying is not allowed.
9. No throwing snowballs, rocks, gravel, sticks, hats, or spruce cones.
10. No food, candy, gum, or beverages on playground.
11. Use play equipment properly. Do not stand on the ends of the seesaw. Do not climb on top of the climbing equipment. Do not climb the trees around the playground.
12. No spitting.
13. Any students fighting, showing extreme misbehavior or disrespect will be sent to the principal.
14. Swings; take turns, no pushes, jumping out of seats, super high swinging.
15. Net Climber; no jumping off the net, no pushing.
16. Tilt Wheel; no hanging on to each other and climbing on top of the tilt wheel.
